## 1. ENTRY

1.1 By submitting your application and paying your entry fee you are agreeing to enter the Children's Cancer Run and also agree to abide by these Conditions of Entry, and any instructions given to you by the organisers and officials of the run.

## 2. CHANGE OF ADDRESS

2.1 If your address details change after you have submitted your application, please inform us by emailing <a href="mailto:childrenscancerrun@neccr.org.uk">childrenscancerrun@neccr.org.uk</a>. Approximately 4 weeks before the event your run pack will be sent to the address held at that point.

## 3. EVENT SAFETY

- 3.1 At all times during the Children's Cancer Run you must adhere to all instructions given by the event officials.
- 3.2 It is your responsibility to ensure that you have the correct equipment, footwear and clothing for the event, taking the weather conditions into account.
- 3.3 You are not permitted to be accompanied by your pets or other animals when participating in the event.
- 3.4 All Children's Cancer Run participants must display a valid running number at all times. Your personal details must be completed on the reverse of your run number, including emergency contact details.
- 3.5 You are not permitted to use any item that could potentially inhibit the flow or safety of other participants or which we, in our reasonable opinion, deem may cause danger or risk of danger to you or other participants.
- 3.6 You warrant to North of England Children's Cancer Research that you are, and will be on the event date, sufficiently fit and healthy to participate in the Children's Cancer Run. If you are in any doubt we recommend that you seek medical advice.
- 3.7The Children's Cancer Run is a cross country run over uneven ground and through woodland. By submitting this registration form you understand the potential risks of trips or falls in running over this type

of surface.

## 4. EVENT EJECTION

- 4.1 We reserve the right to refuse entry to the Children's Cancer Run or ask you to cease participation if:-
- 4.1.1 you fail to follow instructions given by event officials;
- 4.1.2 you attempt to participate in the run in a manner that we, acting reasonably, believe:-
- (a) may cause injury to you;
- (b) may cause injury to another participant;
- (c) may damage or harm the environment;
- (d) is likely to cause offence; or
- (e) otherwise causes a risk or potential risk to health and safety
- 4.1.3 in our opinion you are unfit to participate in the Event due to:-
- (a) the consumption of alcohol;
- (b) the use of drugs;
- (c) an injury or illness

#### 5. CANCELLATION BY NECCR

- 5.1 We may cancel the Children's Cancer Run if circumstances beyond our reasonable control arise, including, without limitation, war, civil or political unrest, terrorism or inclement weather conditions.
- 5.2 In such circumstances:-
- 5.2.1we will endeavour to stage the event at a later date either at the same venue or at an alternative venue. Any changes to the event will be communicated to you at the event or sooner if practicable;
- 5.2.2 you will have the right to take part in the re-staged event; and
- 5.2.3 if you are unable to take part in the re-staged event you will receive a refund of the fees.

## 6. DATA PROTECTION

- 6.1 You agree that your Personal Information can be stored, used by NECCR and our event partners in connection with the organisation, staging and administration of the Children's Cancer Run.
- 7. You agree that your image can be used by NECCR and our event partners for the purposes of the promotion and marketing of the event.

7.1 By agreeing to the terms and conditions you will receive a number of information emails which will include latest updates on the Children's Cancer Run.

## 8. CHANGES TO THE EVENT

8.1 We reserve the right to reduce the course distance, change the course, or make any other amendment to the run that we deem necessary to stage the event. Any change to the event will be communicated to you at the event or sooner if practicable.

## 9. USE OF IMAGE

9.1 The Children's Cancer Run may be televised and photographs may be taken which capture your participation in the event. You agree to the publication of photographs and broadcasts of your image which accurately depict your participation in the event.

## 10. MEDICAL CONDITIONS

- 10.1 It is strongly recommended that you train for the Children's Cancer Run and prepare for the challenge. If you have not exercised before or for some time, you should consult your doctor before commencing your training for the event.
- 10.2 You must complete all the required medical information fields on the back of your race number prior to participating in the event. Medical information will only be used to allow medical assistance to be given on the event date.

## 11. LIABILITY

- 11.1 In no event shall we be liable to you, whether for breach of contract, any tortious act or omission (including negligence) or otherwise, under or in connection with the Agreement for any:
- 11.1.1 loss or damage;
- 11.1.2 loss of profit;
- 11.1.3 loss of reputation;
- 11.1.4 loss of business, revenue or goodwill;
- 11.1.5 loss of anticipated savings;
- 11.1.6 pledges made on your behalf or by you to charity; or
- 11.1.7 consequential or indirect loss, regardless of whether the loss or damage:
- (a) would arise in the ordinary course of events;
- (b) is reasonably foreseeable; or
- (c) is in the contemplation of the parties, or otherwise.

- 11.2 Nothing in this Agreement shall affect our liability for death or personal injury, fraud, or any other liability to the extent it cannot be excluded or limited by law.
- 11.3 We shall procure and maintain appropriate third party liability insurance for the Event for our own benefit. You:
- (a) acknowledge that you are not entitled to benefit under such insurance where any claim is made against you by a third party for death, personal injury or damage to property arising out of or in connection with your negligent actions or omissions whilst participating in the event; and
- (b) shall indemnify us and keep us indemnified against any claim made against us by a third party for death, personal injury or damage to property arising out of or in connection with your negligent actions or omissions whilst participating in the event.

#### 12. REFUND POLICY

12.1 Once we have confirmed your participation in the event we will not provide any refund if you choose to cancel the Agreement other than in accordance with Condition 5.

# 13. SUPERVISION OF CHILDREN

13.1 All children aged 16 years and under must be accompanied and supervised by an adult during the event.
