1. When is the event?
Saturday 20th July



2. What time does the event start?
The Event Village will open at 09:00am, with the car park opening its doors at 08:30am. The 100km cycle start time is 10:00am, and the 50km start time is 10:30am.

3. What time does it finish?
The event will finish once all of the cyclists are safely back. There is food served after the cycle.



4. Where do the routes start and finish.
Both cycle routes will start at the Event Village located at Murphy Surveys' headoffice in Kilcullen.

The 50km route is suited to a beginner level with a good level of fitness.

10. Do I need to wear a helmet?

All riders need to wear a helmet at all times during the cycle ride.

- Suitable attire including waterproof clothing and footwear
- Helmet
- Sunscreen
- Puncher repair kit (just in case)



14. What happens if it's raining?

We'll keep our fingers crossed for great weather, but just in case please ensure you are appropriately dressed and prepared for all weather conditions.



15. Do I have to fundraise?

100% of your registration fee will go to the CMRF Crumlin. But in order to reach our target we would love for our riders to raise some sponsorship money using the donation link via the registration page.

17. What happens if I have an injury on the ride?

We have an emergency number that all riders will have prior to the event. We'll also have first aiders available just in case.



18. Do I need insurance?

All riders will need a valid Cycling Ireland membership / licence to take part in this event. If you don't hold a valid licence you can simply purchase one when you register online at a cost of €5. Any participant who does not hold licence will not be allowed to ride.
